Under the BIS Compulsory Registration Scheme, foreign manufacturers have been nominating an Indian Representative to liaise between the manufacturer and BIS. The Indian Representative is required to sign an Agreement with BIS that they will abide by the terms and conditions of the Agreement, and BIS Act, Rules & Regulations.

In this regard, manufacturers are advised to ensure that the Indian Representative nominated by them will not engage with any other activity of BIS or related to BIS, for example, testing of samples, involving in the activities of laboratories recognized by BIS; undertaking market surveillance etc. as such activity may involve conflict of interest under the Compulsory Registration Scheme.

In case, it is detected at any stage that the Indian Representative is engaged in any of the above mentioned activities or any other activity related to BIS functions that involve conflict of interest, the Registration awarded to manufacturers is liable to be cancelled.
